

Supporting documents for applications for Master's degree programs/PhD programs at FAU

Applications for Master's degree programs are processed by the Master's Office rooms 0.032 and 0.048 (international applicants) or rooms 0.049 and 0.050 (German applicants), Halbmondstr. 6, 91054 Erlangen. Applications should be submitted exclusively via the online portal 'campo'. More information on the application procedure is available at: <http://www.master.fau.eu>

During the online application process at www.campo.fau.eu, you are requested to **upload** your application documents to the upload section as a PDF file. These include:

- **All documents which provide a record of your education** (secondary education certificate(s), transcript of records, university degree certificate (where applicable), diploma supplement, CV). In the case of qualifications obtained in countries other than Germany, officially certified copies are required for the qualifications and the translation thereof. A translation is not required for documents issued in German, English or French.
- Applicants who completed their first degree in **China or Vietnam** also require an **APS certificate** which must be uploaded when applying for a Master's degree program.
- **APS India:** Applicants who completed their first degree in **India** also require an APS certificate. **From summer semester 2025**, the APS certificate must be uploaded when applying for a Master's degree program. Please note: The APS certificate for India is already required with immediate effect when applying for a **study visa** in Germany.
